Separate fully equipped ICU and ER treatment areas, endoscopy, cystoscopy, Arthrex nanoscope, 3 ultrasound machines (2 ultrasound rooms), canine and feline intermediate care wards, I131 ward, separate pharmacy and diagnostic lab, 15 exam rooms, large isolation room, oxygen generators (including emergency power back-up systems.)
